

## How to Connect your Gateway to NBN

If the gateway is provided by Commander (MP264), please follow the directions contained in the Quick Start Guide contained in the box.

This unit will automatically configure itself on your Commander NBN service.

If you are providing your own device, there are a few aspects that need to be considered to ensure that your service is able to connect.

1. The authentication details provided by us will be required to connect to your Commander NBN service using PPPoE. Your WAN IP address and DNS Servers etc... will be automatically obtained.
2. The Commander NBN Service will be delivered via an RJ45 UNI-D port on the NBN Co Network Terminating Device (NTD). This service will be 802.1Q VLAN tagged on VLAN 100.
3. If your gateway supports DNS Relay, you can take advantage of that feature or configure DNS servers as documented at the link below.
